Tuesday 28th November at 1:30pm - Year 12 (Musical Theatre, Music, Games Development & New Media, Broadcast and Music Technology)

As the performances are matinees, students who have lessons in the morning will be walked over to the Old Rep Theatre with supervised members of staff at 12:45pm. After the performances, the students will be dismissed straight from the theatre. The performances will finish at approximately 4:00pm. If any students are to be picked up from BOA staff will be returning to BOA and will accompany them. If this applies, please put a note with the reply slip below.

Students who do not have additionals and therefore only have lessons in the afternoon will be required to meet directly at the Old Rep Theatre at 1:00pm. Please note - these theatre visits are compulsory as they are during Pathway time and registers will be taken before each performance.

Students in Year 10 and 11 will need to bring a packed lunch with them, as there will not be enough time to buy lunch from the canteen before departing BOA unless they purchase it at break earlier in the day.
